2022 Introductory Course in Underwater Archaeology



Would you like to dive with MAHS to conduct research on historic shipwrecks and help preserve our national maritime heritage? Then this course is for you.

The Maritime Archaeological and Historical Society (MAHS) is accepting applications for its 34th annual Introductory Course in Underwater Archaeology starting Tuesday January 25, 2022.

The course consists of nine evening classes (7:30 to 9:30 pm) on Tuesday nights, plus one pool session. Classes will be conducted online by Zoom again this year so students need access to a computer to attend. The course is open to all interested persons whether a certified diver or not. Cost is \$175 pp.

Once you have completed this course, if you are a certified scuba diver, you will be eligible to sign up for the MAHS Field School where you will participate with other students in surveying a shipwreck or other underwater site. Thereafter, you may volunteer to participate with MAHS in future projects.
